



PAST PRESIDENT GUIDELINES

1. Represent the VHIMA as a delegate to the AHIMA House of Delegates during the National Convention provided Virginia is entitled to five Delegates based on membership.
2. Advise VHIMA President, as requested, on issues facing the business of the VHIMA.
3. Participate, if able, in AHIMA's Hill Day held in Washington, DC in March of every year. Serve as VHIMA liaison with Virginia's legislature. Work, if applicable, with the Secretary of Technology and/or Secretary of Health and Human Resources regarding the Electronic Health Record.
4. Serve as Committee Chair for organizing a VHIMA Hill Day in Richmond.
5. Sign on to the Governor's Mailing List to stay abreast of all issues facing the VHIMA, particularly the electronic health record. The VHIMA wants to be involved with the State as it continues its plan to implement the electronic record in the Commonwealth.
